

Spring 2010 Share Projection

This is our working projection for the spring share and what we base our plantings on. The weeks are listed across the top and crops are listed to the left. We've made an estimate of the value of each item and there is a "1" in the box that corresponds to the week we hope to give out the item. The actual spring share will depend on weather, and how well each planting works, as well as when things actually mature, not when we want them to mature. This should at least give an idea of what types of vegetables we're growing, and roughly the size of a share each week. The two weeks in gray are our "spring break" and are weeks we plan to not harvest.

Spring is a bit of a gamblers season and is very weather dependent. If the weather is cold and wet we'll have a very different share than if things are warm and dry. Typically March and early April are the most difficult months to get consistent harvests in our area.
